Dear Parents & Carers,

The weather has been as confusing as ever the last two weeks. Could we all be vigilant in school attire to suit the changing weather. If you feel it is going to be a cool start to the day and dress your child in tracksuit or jumpers could you please provide shorts and sun hat in case of extreme changes. Alternately if the day starts warm and a cold change comes through could you please provide warm clothing in your child's bag. Summer is looking increasingly hot and dry this year, so please provide an addition drink for your child each day over the warmer months.

To parents in the school who may live in bush fire prone areas, please create, with the assistance of the Rural Fire Service, a bushfire plan that includes emergency contacts and arrangements for the school in the unlikely event that your child is unable to be delivered home.

Furthermore, can I reassure parents that in the event of a natural disaster and your child is in transit, School Assisted Travel are directed to return students to school first if safe to do so, otherwise they are directed to take them to the nearest Police Station or Family and Community Services.

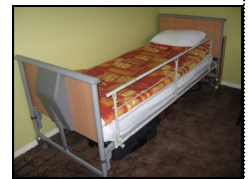
