

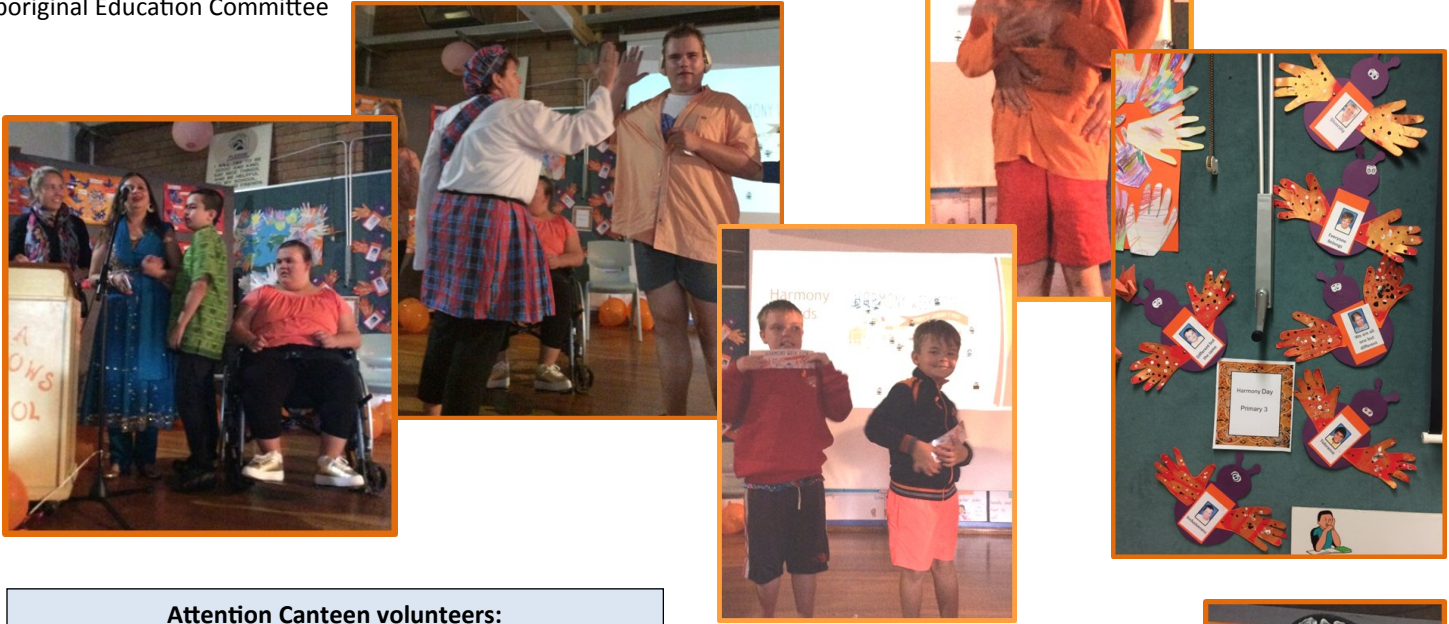
GOODBYE SUELLEN and KATE

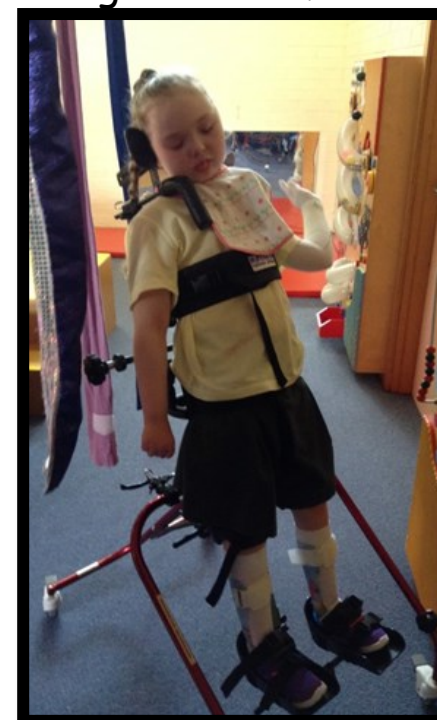
