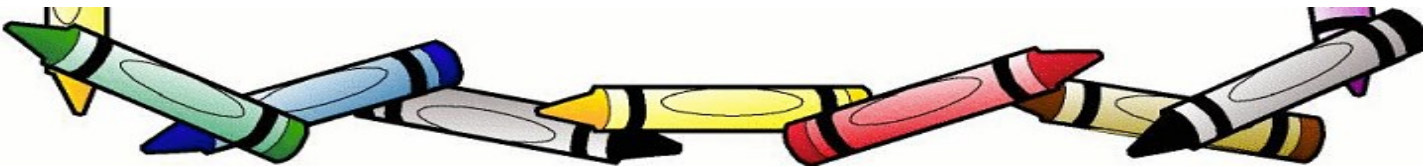

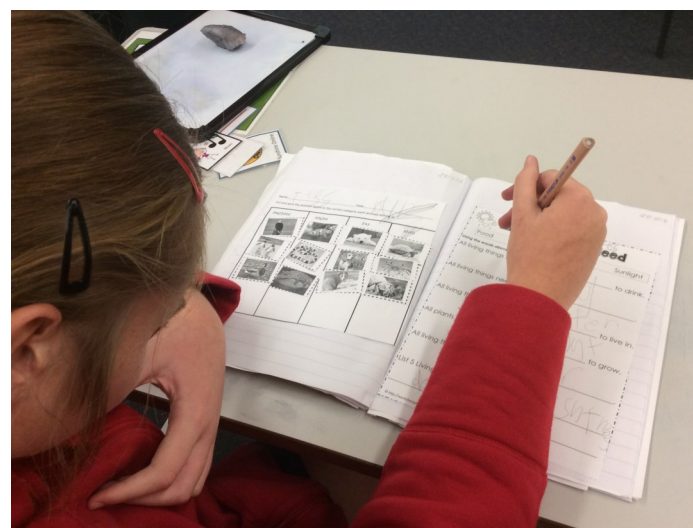
HS 4

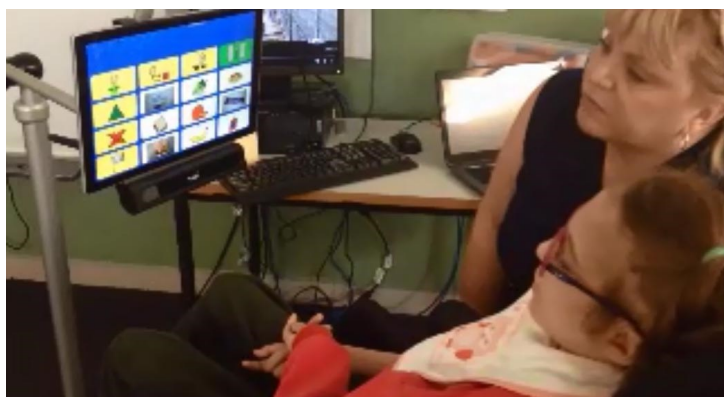
ART
