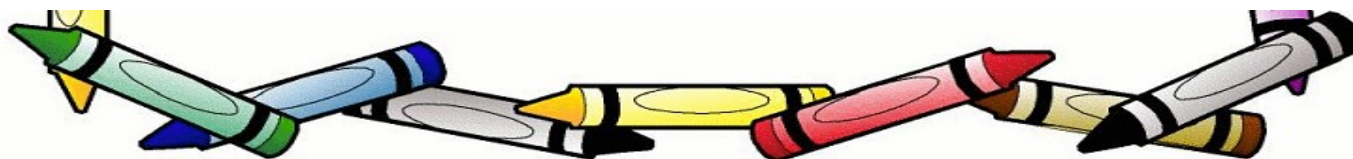

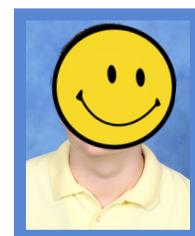
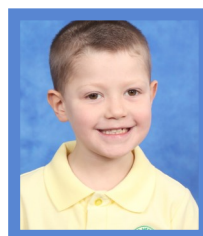
We also wish young Hardy great success as he transitions to his local primary school, we are very proud of the steps you have taken in building your social skills ready for mainstream.

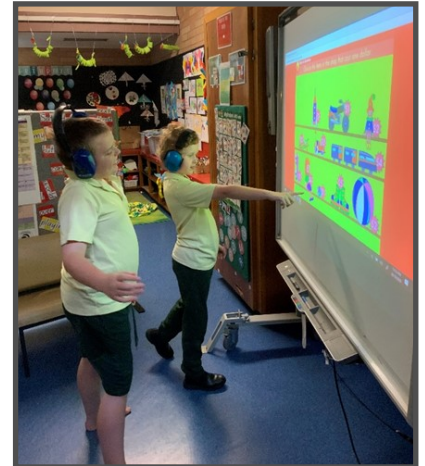
