







The NSW Department of Education - through School Infrastructure NSW - has contracted the University of Technology Sydney (UTS) to undertake a pilot research project as part of its Disability Strategy.

The research project is looking at the design and physical environment of schools and how they can better support learning and wellbeing outcomes for students with disability.

Your school was selected by the Department as it has a specific student profile, building age, size and/or location to support meaningful research on the strengths, and possible shortcomings, of current school environments likely to be in common with other NSW schools.

The UTS research team- led by the Institute for Public Policy and Governance - is using several research tools to study each pilot school (nine in total). These include surveys, focus groups, and interviews, plus an observational tool to record specific features of the school. The research also includes a review of the evidence base related to best practice school design for students with disability.
